and


Tuesday March 28th 6:00-7:30

Cutting the cord?

We live in a time where many of us no longer have home phones and instead use our cell phones.

Many of us have the same complaints about our cable service, too expensive, I only watch 2 or 3 channels, there has to be a better way.

If you don't record much on a DVR or only watch a few channels, there might be an option for you.

There are several products on the market that make it easier to cut the cord, Roku, Amazon Fire Stick, Apple TV and Google Chrome Cast. While all 4 work a little differently the basic concept is the same. Most, if not all, content providers allow you to watch their programming online.

For years now smart TV's have included a limited selection of "apps" that allow you to use Netflix, HULU, Pandora, etc. However, there is usually not a way to add options to the built in selections. This is where the stick adds functionality. It plugs into an HDMI port on your TV and links to an account that allows you to choose from up to 7,000 "channels". Some are free while some require a subscription, but you get to pick and choose what you add. They access the internet through your wireless network.

If you are a heavy user of the DVR and you record hours of TV to watch later then this may not be a good option for you, but for those of you that really want to cut the cord there is a choice.
